### Devotional

Even though Job couldn't sense God's presence, he believed He was present and affirmed his commitment to God's purpose in this test and his continued obedience to God's Word, which were the most important issues in his life. Job's resignation to God's sovereignty faltered at times in practice, but he returned to it repeatedly.
